



MEETING CONCLUSION

Technical Working Group Meeting of the South East Asia National Human Rights Institutions Forum (SEANF)

**ORIA HOTEL, JAKARTA, INDONESIA
25-26 SEPTEMBER 2014**

The South East Asia National Human Rights Institutions Forum (SEANF) consisting of the National Human Rights Commission of Indonesia [Komisi Nasional Hak Asasi Manusia (Komnas HAM)], the Human Rights Commission of Malaysia [Suruhanjaya Hak Asasi Manusia Malaysia (SUHAKAM)], the Myanmar National Human Rights Commission (MNHRC), the Commission on Human Rights of the Philippines (CHRP), the National Human Rights Commission of Thailand (NHRCT), and the Provedor for Human Rights and Justice of Timor Leste (PDHJ), held the *Technical Working Group (TWG) Meeting of the SEANF* in Jakarta, Indonesia on 25-26 September 2014 .

The Meeting noted the following :

1. The Forum agreed on the agenda for the TWG meeting.
2. Komnas HAM delivered a brief presentation on the Rules of Procedure on SEANF's Permanent Secretariat.
3. Komnas HAM will send to all member NHRIs the proposed Rules of Procedure on SEANF's Permanent Secretariat for comments and additional inputs, if necessary. The draft will be discussed further during the 11th Annual Meeting of SEANF.
4. The Myanmar National Human Rights Commission (MNHRC) provided an update on SEANF's engagement with the ASEAN Intergovernmental Commission on Human Rights (AICHR).
5. The Commission on Human Rights of the Philippines (CHRP) presented the features and functions of the SEANF website as well as the Facebook group page. All members are encouraged to provide reports or messages related to

human rights that may be shared with each other as well as to the public for information and guidance.

6. The MNHRC postponed the Regional Workshop on Trafficking in Persons which is planned to be implemented in 2015.
7. Komnas HAM reported on the highlights during the Workshop on Land Rights held in Cambodia last 16 – 17 September 2014.
8. At the side meeting of SEANF members during the Asia Pacific Forum (APF) Annual Meeting in New Delhi, India, it was agreed that the issues on older persons (by SUHAKAM) and SEANF's position on two (2) United Nations (UN) resolutions on business and human rights (by CHRP) shall be included in the agenda of the annual meeting in November.
9. The Forum agreed that the proposed agenda for the annual meeting regarding the Seminar of General Election be changed to "Peace and Security".
10. The Forum agreed on the amendments for the proposed agenda for SEANF's 11th Annual Meeting which will be held on 5 – 6 November 2014 in Bali, Indonesia.
11. Komnas HAM will send to all NHRIs formal letter providing the proposed list of observers to be invited at the 11th Annual Meeting of SEANF.
